Politically, respect for citizens requires a public discourse that is open to all viewpoints. Going beyond the question of free speech versus religion, *The Future of Blasphemy* defends an ethical model of blasphemy. Controversies surrounding sacrilege are contests over what counts as sacred, disagreements about what has central, inviolable, and incommensurable value. In such public contestation of the sacred, each of us "secular and religious alike" has equal right to speak on its behalf.
